Regular Meeting 6:00 P.M.
April 13, 2015

Present: Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Secretary Valena Garlin, and Solicitor Guy Beneventano.

Chairman Worley called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Worley made a motion 1) to approve the Minutes from the March 9, 2015 meeting and 2) to approve the Treasurer's Report of March 31, 2015. The motion was seconded by Larry and carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT (1)

Carl Wickline Manager and Tom Eiler, President for York Spring fire and ambulance were present and stated earlier that day they brought in copies of the 2015 budget. He asked if the supervisors had any questions. The supervisors said they appreciated receiving the report and do not have any questions. Carl stated they have paid employees and volunteers on the ambulance staff. Having properly trained people is critical to effective operation.

POLICE REPORT

Chief Mike Weigand gave the following report for the period of March 8 – April 12, 2015: There were 296 calls for service, 6,014 miles patrolled, 437 duty hours logged, 56 traffic citations, 67 traffic warnings and 2 non traffic citations. The Department participated in 3 DUI patrols and 6 U.S. Marshal details.

The next crime watch meeting will be April 23, 2015 at 7 PM at the township building.

Chief Weigand reminded everyone that the next Prescription Drug Take-Back is scheduled for April 25, 2015 at the Bermudian Springs High School from 10 A.M. to 2 P.M.

On May 3rd "Make a Wish" will be doing their annual convoy for wishes. There will be some traffic congestion in the East Berlin area.

ROAD REPORT

Larry reported that the winter has taken a toll on the roads. The road crew has been working to repair the pot holes.

Larry stated the Soccer teams are practicing on the fields.

OLD BUSINESS

Larry Dost made a motion to ratify the contracts for the York Springs Fire and Ambulance. Dan Worley seconded, motion carried

PLANNING COMMISSION

NEW BUSINESS

Dan made a motion seconded by Larry to adopt Adams County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan by Resolution 2015-1. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Dan Worley made a motion to advertise the stone and seal coat bids. The bids will be sent out in the next couple days. The bids will be opened at the May meeting. Larry Dost seconded the motion and motion carried by unanimous vote.

Larry Dost make a motion seconded by Dan Worley to accept the bills list as submitted. Motion carried.

SUPERVISORS' COMMENTS

Larry stated during the winter months the road crew had problems obtaining salt like many other municipalities. The township was able to borrow 25 tons from the State. The township has paid back the salt borrowed to the Heidlersburg maintenance shed. The township sent a thank you to the State for their help. Mike Weigand helped the supervisors find the contact for the State.

The insurance company agreed to start building the township maintenance building. The building should be up before winter. There was a lot of arguing with the insurance company but the township would not accept any short cuts. There were several meetings with the insurance company and their consultant who tried to cut back on what the insurance company would pay. This was the first municipal fire for the insurance company. Since the fire was caused by a faulty heater, the insurance company will subrogate and get the money back from the heating company. The township will have a new building constructed with no cost to the township. Some of the equipment could be refurbished. A truck, backhoe and tractor had to be replaced. The insurance company paid to have this equipment replaced.

ADJOURNMENT

Dan made a motion, seconded by Larry to adjourn. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 6:30 P.M.
