REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael Weigand reported that there were 161 calls for service, 3,795 miles patrolled, 29 traffic citations, 24 warnings, 0 non-traffic citations, and 0 criminal arrests. He announced the National Drug Take Back Day Saturday, April 28, 2018 from 10 AM to 2PM at the Bermudian Springs School District. He also reported that the Adams County Police Memorial Service (Adams County Fallen Heroes) will be held May 4th at 10:00 AM at the Adams County 911 Center on 230 Greenamyre Lane, Gettysburg, PA. He noted that there will be 58 fallen law enforcement members dating back to the 1800's that will be recognized.

Engineer's Report: John Shambaugh reported that a letter had been sent to a resident concerning the water run-off from his sump pump onto the roadway. The resident has been given 30 days to comply with the letter. Dan Worley requested that he would follow-up with pictures of the mentioned area of water run-off

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that the snowplows are still on in case any more winter weather should come our way.

Park Report: Woody Myers reported that due to the wet fields at the park, Northern Soccer is practicing at other ballfields. Also, the Bermudian Springs Soccer is practicing elsewhere until the weather cooperates.

Chairman Dan Worley called the regular meeting to order at 10:00 AM.

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the road project bid for 12.5 mm Superpave from NESL for the cost of \$197,775.00. He noted that everyone he had spoken to on the issue, including the PennDot representative, recommended the 12.5 mm Superpave option as being the most durable for the type of traffic on Old U.S. Route 15. It will also be a less expensive option in the long term due to the fact that it does not require a seal coat for approx. 10-15 years. This will save approx. \$40,000.

Larry Dost seconded the motion. Motion carried.
