REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Mike Weigand gave the police report of July 13, 2014. There were 182 calls for service, 3,522 miles patrolled, 338.5 duty hours, 38 traffic citations, 25 warnings, and 6 US Marshall Details.

NEW BUSINESS

Dan Worley made a motion to advertise the salt bids. He noted the salt must be pink Chilean salt and a certificate stating it is pink Chilean salt must be provided with the bid. The pink salt does not clump like the other salt. Last year Cargill said they would provide pink Chilean salt but it is not what they provided. Woody Myers seconded the motion and motion carried by unanimous vote.
