**Regular Meeting**  
August 8, 2016; 6:00 PM

**Present:** Chairman Daniel Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Secretary Megan Colby, Chief Michael Weigand, and visitors listed on the attendance sheet.

Chairman Daniel Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the Minutes of the July 11, 2016, Regular Meeting and to approve the Treasurer's Report of July 31, 2016. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

**REPORTS**

**Police Report:** Chief Michael E. Weigand gave the police report for July 11, 2016, through August 6, 2016. There were 77 calls for service, 1632 miles patrolled, 165.5 duty hours, 2 traffic citations, 3 traffic warnings, and 1 criminal arrest.

Chief Weigand stated that he had followed up on the three concerns raised by residents at the Board of Supervisors Meeting on July 11, 2016. These concerns were regarding speed enforcement near Braggtown Road. Chief Weigand said that there is now a message-board speed sign from PennDOT by the road and that resident Mr. Clymer (who had attended the July 11 meeting) was happy. Dan Worley thanked Chief Weigand for addressing those matters promptly.

Larry Dost asked how the new officer, Derek Smith, was doing, and Chief Weigand replied that he is doing well and getting to know the Township.

**Engineer's Report:** None

**Road Report:** Woody Myers reported that some maintenance is being done on the roads, as needed. He also stated that he has been able to replace or find some of the road signs that were stolen or vandalized recently. Woody Myers emphasized that the vandalism of these signs costs the taxpayers money and that it is hoped those responsible would realize this.

**Park Report:** Woody Myers reported that the park is going well and that there will be a lot of children there once the soccer season starts again in September. Dan Worley added that there are some improvements being done at the park and that resident Jeff Painter is working on a new sign to be placed at the entrance to the park. Woody Myers noted that the vandalism in the Township included some stolen signs at the park and that there is a picture from the security camera which

shows what time the signs were stolen. The picture is not clear enough, however, to determine who is responsible or what vehicle was used.
