**Regular Meeting**  
December 9, 2019; 6:00 PM

**Present:** Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Chief Michael Weigand, Secretary Jennie Gordon. 1 Visitor.

Chairman Dan Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Chairman Dan Worley made a motion to approve the minutes of the Budget Workshop, Special Hearing, and Regular Meeting for November 11, 2019. He also motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report of November 30, 2019. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Mary Jane Ziegler attended to discuss the issues that have been going on at EMMR (Eastern Museum of Motor Racing) and the fairgrounds. The issues that were discussed was the lack of transparency and equipment running at all hours. She inquired as to the current situation between Latimore Township and the EMMR. Dan Worley responded that the area in question is not a legal campground area. They were allowed to use it for events only. He said it appeared they just moved some of the campers to store on the hill which continues to be violating the zoning ordinance. He said that they are working with the township solicitor in order to get them to clean up the property.

**Police Report:** Chief Michael Weigand reported for 11/9/19-12/7/19 that there were 230 calls for service, 3,746 miles patrolled, 17 traffic citations, 52 warnings, 0 non-traffic citation and 1 criminal arrest.
