February 9, 2015

Present: Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Solicitor Guy Beneventano, Secretary Valena Garlin and visitors listed on the attendance sheet. Township Engineer John Shambaugh was absent.

Chairman Dan Worley called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Dan Worley made a motion 1) to approve the Minutes from the January 5, 2015 meeting and 2) to approve the Treasurer's Report of January 31, 2015. The motion was seconded by Woody Myers and carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC COMMENT (1)** Dean Green, the new fire chief for York Springs Fire Company, came to introduce himself and give the fire report for 2014. He stated there were 144 calls for 2014, of which 17% were for Latimore Township. The fire company had an average of 8 people per call. They joined York County Fire School and a lot of people are signing up for classes

**POLICE REPORT**

Chief Mike Weigand submitted the following report for the period of January 1 through February 7, 2015: There were 240 calls for service and 4,735 miles patrolled, 57 training hours, 38 traffic citations issued, and 31 traffic warnings. The Department participated in 3 U.S. Marshal details.

The next Crime Watch meeting will be held Thursday April 23, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. at the Latimore Township Building.

The Latimore Township Police Department will be participating in Criminal Justice Day with Harrisburg Area Community College in Gettysburg on February 27<sup>th</sup>. This is where individuals who are interesting in pursuing a job in law enforcement can meet and talk to people with police departments and other agencies.

There will be a Relay for Life 5K race on March 14, 2015. It will leave from Rice Park and come up through York Springs and Latimore Township.

The DEA discontinued the drug take back program. Adams County District Attorney's Office decided to do the program for Adams County. Bermudian Springs School District will still be the collection site for drop offs. The first collection date will be April 25, 2015 from 10 AM to 2 PM. The second collection date will be September 26, 2015.
