Present: Chairman Daniel "Dan" Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Solicitor Guy Beneventano, Township Engineer John Shambaugh, Secretary Valena Garlin and visitors listed on the attendance sheet.

Chairman Worley called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Worley made a motion 1) to approve the Minutes from the June 11, 2012 meeting and 2) to approve the Treasurer's Report of June 30, 2012. The motion was seconded by Woody and carried unanimously.

POLICE REPORT – Chief Michael E. Weigand

Chief Weigand submitted the following report for the period June 11, 2012 – July 8, 2012: There were 212 calls for service, 3,509 miles patrolled and 322 duty-hours logged plus an additional six (6) training hours. There were 93 traffic citations, 33 warnings and two (2) non-traffic citations. The Department participated in one (1) D.U.I. patrol and three (3) U.S. Marshal details. Note: There is a typographical error in the number of D.U.I. patrols on the written report; one (1) is the correct number, not 12.

The next Neighborhood Crime Watch Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, July 26, 2012 in the Latimore Township Building at 7:00 P.M.

The York Springs Fire Company Carnival is scheduled for July 26, 27 and 28, 2012. The Police Department plans to be a presence at the carnival.

The Department will attend a press conference concerning the Traffic Safety on Route 15 Campaign planned for Monday, July 23, 2012 at Members 1st in Dillsburg. Receipt of additional grant money for the campaign is expected in July and August.

National Night Out is Tuesday, August 7, 2012. Activities will be held at the Lake Meade ball field, same location as last year, from 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. Additional attractions for this year are the Life Lion helicopter and child I.D. and fingerprinting.

A fifth Take-Back event at Bermudian Springs High School is in the planning stages for Saturday, September 29, 2012. Chief Weigand noted that historically the Township has done

well, increasing the amount of prescription drugs collected each time. He also noted Adams County ranked 11th in the last collection.

Woody requested confirmation of the National Night Out date and time so the Supervisors can put it on their calendar and attend.

Road Report: Woody reported all roads planned for repair are finished. Also, all Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)-funded repairs have been completed. Woody provided a list of the roads repaired which is available for review at the Township Office.
