Regular Meeting
July 8, 2019; 6:00 PM

Present: Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Chief Michael Weigand, Engineer John Shambaugh, Secretary Jennie Gordon. 2 Visitors.

Chairman Dan Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Dan Worley made a motion to approve the minutes of June 10, 2019. He also motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report of June 30, 2019. Larry Dost seconded, and motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. Tom Eyler attended to represent York Springs Fire Co. He discussed how the fire company would like to ask the municipalities to consider covering the cost of the Workmen's Compensation for the career people at the Ambulance Co. They are considering using a payment per call basis for this. Latimore had 96 calls in 2018 which would be \$.5568 per call. That is strictly Workmen's Compensation costs. Latimore currently contributes to Workmen's Compensation for the volunteers of the Fire Company. He explained that they are their own employer now that the hospitals are no longer interested in being a part of it. Medic units do come out of hospitals. He went on to explain the differences in training for the EMT's and the Medic Units. He answered Dan Worley's question about the need for so many ambulances in the area. Chief Weigand also added that there is a need for such, as multiple calls are having to be met simultaneously.

2. Vince Umstot attended to bring a pothole on Town Hill to the attention of the supervisors. He also requested that something be done about a building on Town Hill that had been demolished and the scrap lumber was left behind that he thought created an eyesore. He also was concerned about another nearby property on Town Hill. Chief Weigand agreed to stop by and ask the property owner what the plans for the property were. Dan Worley responded to Mr. Umstot that it was necessary that he file an official complaint form for further action to take place.

REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael Weigand reported for 6/8/19-7/7/19 that there were 236 calls for service, 3,327 miles patrolled, 20 traffic citations, 39 warnings, 0 non-traffic citation and 0 criminal arrest. He stated that there has been an increase in aggressive driving. Officer Weigand also reported one DUI arrest the prior day.

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that the tar and chipping contracts have been completed on Ridge Road and other contracted roads. He said they were well pleased about the jobs that were done by Hammaker East.

Park Report: Woody Myers said there was nothing going on currently at the park.
