Regular Meeting 6:00 P.M.

June 13, 2011

Present: Chairman Daniel “Dan” Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Secretary Valena Garlin, Township Engineer John Shambaugh and Solicitor Guy Beneventano. There were no visitors.

Chairman Worley called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Worley made a motion 1) to approve the Minutes from the May 9, 2011 meeting and 2) to approve the Treasurer's Report of May 31, 2011. The motion was seconded by Woody and carried unanimously.

**POLICE REPORT**

**Chief Michael Weigand** submitted the following report:

For the period of May 9, 2011 – June 12, 2011 there were 218 calls for service, 6,700 miles patrolled, 428 man-hours logged and 16 training hours. There were ninety (90) traffic citations issued, 12 traffic warnings and 10 non-traffic incidents including one (1) criminal offense, one (1) harassment charge and eight (8) criminal mischief charges.

The next Crime Watch meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 23, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Building. Chief Weigand noted the Bike Patrol is in operation; Officer Finnegan was out this past Saturday (June 11, 2011). He expressed appreciation to the Board of Supervisors and to members of Crime Watch for getting the Bicycle Unit up and running.

Chief Weigand recommended the Board approve the Police Patrol Agreement with Bermudian Springs School District from August 1, 2011 – August 1, 2012 as listed on the Agenda under New Business. Chairman Worley moved immediately to this item and made a motion to approve said Agreement. Woody seconded, all agreed and the motion carried.

Larry had questions about laws pertaining to Improper Passing, specifically on a solid line, a yellow line and passing right around someone waiting to make a left turn. Chief Weigand answered that unless a section of road is posted as “No Passing Zone,” passing is permitted.

Larry also asked about police jurisdiction in a private parking lot. Chief Weigand responded no, not unless there is an agreement within defined parameters.

## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Engineer's Report:** No report.

**Road Report:** Woody reported all stone has been received and the road crew, including the Supervisors, has been preparing the roads by putting down clear patch, cleaning gutters and mowing. Hammaker hopes to begin work by the end of June.

**Park Report:** Woody reported there had been some vandalism this past weekend. Someone had used a cutter on the back of the tin and removed 16 screws. The perpetrators attempted to break in at the back but nothing seemed to be missing. The incident has been reported; Chief Weigand concurred. Dan noted there are plans to place additional lights to increase security.

## **SOLICITOR'S REPORT – Guy Beneventano**

**PLANNING COMMISSION:** subdivisions/modules/land developments

**Rickert & Junkins Development Agreement:** Dan explained this agreement is to protect the Township by holding the Developers accountable to the terms of the agreement. He also noted most developers share the cost of preparation as a courtesy; however, Solicitor Beneventano confirmed this is not required by law. He reported Rickert & Junkins are unwilling to contribute. Dan then made a motion, seconded by Larry, to approve the Rickert & Junkins Development Agreement. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Solicitor Beneventano delivered two copies of the Development Agreement and also the Wolfe Agreement, noting each must be signed by the Supervisors in the presence of a Notary Public. Within a week is sufficient time.
