REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael E. Weigand gave the police report for February 12, 2017, through March 11, 2017. There were 159 calls for service, 3467 miles patrolled, 310.5 duty hours, 45 training hours, 16 traffic citations, and 12 traffic warnings.

Chief Weigand informed residents of the Drug Take Back program that will take place on April 29, 2017, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the Bermudian Springs School District. He also indicated that a State of Emergency had been called for the Township starting at 8:00 PM tonight (March 13), in preparation for the heavy snowfall.

Larry Dost made a motion to recognize the State of Emergency that has been called for the snowstorm starting March 13. The State of Emergency will remain in effect until the end of the storm. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that the road crew is gearing up for the heavy snowfall predicted to start tonight (March 13).

Park Report: Woody Myers reported that the soccer season is due to start soon, although the winter weather may interrupt their practice schedule.
