November 11, 2019; 6:00 PM

Present: Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Township Engineer John Shambaugh, Secretary Jennie Gordon. 4 Visitors.

Chairman Dan Worley called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Chairman Dan Worley made a motion to approve the minutes of October 14, 2019. He also motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report of October 31, 2019. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael Weigand was not in attendance. Larry Dost reported for 10/14/19-11/08/19 that there were 178 calls for service, 2,740 miles patrolled, 27 traffic citations, 59 warnings, 0 non-traffic citation and 1 criminal arrest.

Engineer's Report: None

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that they are preparing for the winter and continue patching holes. They have also done some work opening up some of the side gutters on Meadowview.

Park Report: Woody Myers reported that soccer is over for the year. He also reported that the construction of dug-outs for Little League Baseball is soon to begin. He added that this was part of the long-range plan for the park.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Dan Worley motioned to approve the waiver of the Preliminary Phase and the Myers Subdivision Plan. Larry Dost seconded. Motion carried.

2. Dan Worley motioned to approve the waiver of the Preliminary Phase, approve the waiver of a paved driveway, approve the Planning Modules, and approved the Plan for Red Barn. Woody Myers seconded. Motion carried.

3. Dan Worley motioned to approve the advertisement and posting of the proposed 2020 budget. He reported that it included an increase of 2.3% which is in line with inflation and that there has been no tax increase for 20 years. Larry Dost seconded. Motion carried.

4. Dan Worley motioned to approve the Amendment of the Zoning Ordinance which includes removing kennels from the RA District and placing animal hospitals, stables, and riding academics in supplemental use.

5. Dan Worley motioned to advertise to repeal and amend Park Ordinance 1997-1, which applies to the Park Board. Larry Dost seconded. Motion carried.

6. Dan Worley motioned to authorize the solicitor to prepare, file and serve a civil action against William Gove Old Timers for violation of the Latimore Township Zoning Ordinance if necessary. Larry Dost seconded. Motion carried. Dan Worley went on to explain to visitors that this is in regards to the mess around the property with trailer decks, wood piles, etc. He said camping is not permitted in the flood plain. He said this has been an ongoing issue. Whenever it does flood, the wood and debris end up lodged beneath the bridge or downstream.

Larry Dost reported that he had reviewed the bills list and recommended that it be approved as submitted. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried.
