Present: Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Supervisor Woody Myers, Chief Michael Weigand, Secretary Jennie Gordon. No visitors.

Vice-Chairman Larry Dost called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Larry Dost made a motion to approve the Minutes of September 10, 2018 and to approve the Treasurer's Report of September 30, 2018. He reported that the both York Springs and Lake Meade's Fire Companies checks have been sent. Woody Myers seconded, and motion carried.

REPORTS

Police Report: Chief Michael Weigand reported for 9/9/18-10/6/18 there were 141 total calls, 2,512 miles patrolled, 294 duty hours, 24 traffic citations, 15 warnings, and 0 criminal arrests, and 1 DUI Roving Patrol. He announced the Drug Take-Back Program will be held again on Saturday, October 29, 2018 from 10AM-2PM at Bermudian High Schools. He announced that on October 24, 2018 they will be involved in the statewide enforcement of Operation Safe Stop. They will be monitoring school bus stop areas. He also reported sightings of coyotes in the Fickel Hill area and that ewes have been attacked and killed near the Latimore Fairgrounds. Please do not shoot them unless there is imminent threat to livestock. If you see them, please report the count in the pack to the Game Commission. Chief Weigand welcomed part-time Officer Victor Woerner to our Latimore Police Department. He is a retired State Police corporal and Navy veteran. Chief Weigand reported to the Supervisors that the Police Department no longer has a contract with Bermudian Springs School District.

Road Report: Woody Myers reported that they continue to work on potholes.

Park Report: Woody Myers reported that Bermudian Springs and Dillsburg Soccer Clubs continue to play at the park. He also reported that they have had several rentals of the pavilion this past season with only one renter being asked to return to clean trash that was left behind. They complied.
