Regular Meeting 6:00 P.M.
September 14, 2015

Present: Chairman Dan Worley, Vice-Chairman Larry Dost, Solicitor Guy Beneventano, Assistant Secretary Linda Hansen, and visitors listed on the attendance sheet.

Chairman Worley opened the Regular Meeting at 6:00 P.M. and led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Worley made a motion 1) to approve the Minutes from the August 10, 2015 meeting and 2) to approve the Treasurer's Report of August 31, 2015. The motion was seconded by Larry Dost and carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Dave Murphy stated he is concerned about the Latimore Township Police department. Dan stated Mike Weigand made the choice to go back to his former employer, Henkels and McCoy. Larry Dost stated Mike Weigand is now the part time Police Chief for Latimore Township.

Dave Murphy said Chief Weigand is very well liked and wanted to know if the township will have the same amount of police coverage. Mr. Murphy also asked if the township is planning on eliminating the police department. The supervisors stated the township will not be eliminating the police department. There is reduction in police hours due to Mike going part time. Dan verified that Adams County has 43 state police officers. Larry Dost stated Latimore Township has never had a 24/7 police department and the State Police cover the township when no police officer is on duty.

Mrs. Murphy asked if the police presence in Lake Meade will be the same as the past. Larry Dost said from his understanding, any officer on duty will be doing a Lake Meade run. Dan stated they are cutting out Marshal Service, Memorials and DUI patrols to provide maximum police coverage in the township. When asked how many officers are on the police force, the supervisors said there are 5 part time officers.

REPORTS

Police Report – Chief Mike Weigand was not present since he is on vacation, but he gave a written police report to the supervisors for August 9 – September 12, 2015: there were 142 calls for service, 2,996 miles patrolled and 229.5 duty hours logged. There were 3 traffic citations issued, 1 DUI patrol and 5 US Marshal details.

Road Report: Dan reported there has been a lot of paving done on the roads this year.

Park Report: Dan stated the pavilion is being used for picnics.
